

General Rules for All Dummer's Beach Campers

Road Rules:

NEVER park cars, campers or trailers on vacant campsites or paths to the beach.

Do not cut through other campsites please use the paths.

Upon registering, campers will receive their car stickers or hang tag which must be visible at all times.

Speed limit on campground is 5mph and 10mph on entrance road, please watch out for children.

No bicycle riding or swimming after dark.

No camping or campfires on the beach nor are paddle boats, kayaks, chairs, etc are to be left on the beach.

Motorcycle use is limited to in/out trips only. ATV use is limited to trips to dump station or boat towing.

No joyriding

Quiet Time: 10pm to 7am.

Obey all signs and requests by staff.

Guests:

You are responsible for your guests' behavior and actions. If your guests are disruptive to other Campers, they may be asked to exit the campground immediately and it may result in your eviction from the campground. Guests are either designated as "Overnight" or "Daytime". No guests are to be left unattended;

Overnight Guests:

All overnight guests must be registered and paid for in the Canteen. The staff will issue your guest a visitor hang tag. Your site only includes 1 adult and spouse/significant other (maximum of 2 adults per site) plus dependent children under the age of 18 or 22 if a full time student (must provide a student ID when registering). **All others are considered to be your guest and subject to guest fees this include relatives such as parents, siblings, grandchildren or grandparents, your friends and children's friends plus your adult children.** Overnight guests cannot bring in their own equipment; they must stay in your existing equipment.

Overnight Guests Fees:

Age 15 and older-- \$10 per person/Ages 7-14--- \$8 per person/Age 6 and under is free.

Daytime Guests:

Your daytime guests are subject to the Day Guests fees. Daytime guests do not receive a sticker for their car and guests and their cars must be off the campground by 10pm. If your daytime guests decide to stay overnight, please come into the Canteen before 8pm to register and pay the overnight guest fee.

Day Guests Visitor Fees

Age 15 and older-- \$3 per person/Ages 7-14--\$2 per child/Age 6 and under Free)

Car Stickers and Hang Tags and Parking

All cars on the campground after 10pm must have either a sticker or hang tag displayed. After 10pm, any car on the campground without either a sticker or hang tag is subject to a \$100 fine and towing. Any camper allowing others to use their hang tag is subject to \$150 fine and possible eviction.

Seasonals are issued a sticker to be displayed on lower right front windshield above windshield wiper.

Short Terms Campers and Overnight Guests are issued Hang Tags to be displayed on rear view mirror.

Seasonal Picnic Pass are issued a "daytime only" sticker to be displayed on lower right front windshield (these guests must be off the campground by 10pm)

All campers must park their cars on their site without encroaching your neighbor's sites. Registered camper's cars should not be in the parking lot. The parking lot is reserved for daytime, overnight and picnic guests.

Campers near Boat Ramp are allowed only 2 cars per site and vehicles must not block Boat Ramp.

Allowable Equipment on Site

Size of your camper: campers (including hitch) cannot exceed 35'.

Campers must be in good condition and meet code.

There is no subletting or allowing another party to use your campsite.

All your equipment must be contained within your site at all times.

YOUR PAID GUESTS MUST STAY IN YOUR EXISTING EQUIPMENT. NO ADDITIONAL EQUIPMENT MAY BE SET UP. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Site Rules:

Quiet Time: 10pm to 7am. No loud music, swearing or abusive behavior at ANY TIME is strictly enforced and violators may be evicted immediately. After 10pm, children and teenagers must be accompanied by an adult or be on their campsite.

Campfires are allowed but must be contained in a fireplace or a fire ring. Campfires are never to be left unattended.

You must put out your campfire when you go to bed. Do not put any bottles, cans or plastic or garbage bags or food on campfires. Bonfires are not permitted at all.

There is no subleasing of your space to friends or sharing a site.

Bathhouse

Young children (ages 10 and under) must be escorted and supervised while using the bathhouse.

No dishwashing in basins.

Waste water and Pumping:

Please use either of our 2 dumping stations. Or we have a weekly septic pumping service on Tuesdays and Fridays where we pump right at your site. You can sign up and prepay at the canteen for this service.

All your outside sinks must be plumbed to a honey bucket for disposal

Do not dump sewage or gray waste water on the ground. For gray water waste you can either use outside sink on bath buildings or pit toilet to dispose.

Dogs:

Must be registered and proof of current license and shots must be given to Canteen and keep a copy in your camper.

Owners are responsible for their dog's behavior and actions.

Dogs must be on a leash at all times. Dogs are never to be on the beach, the lake or in campground public buildings

Your guests are not allowed to bring their dogs.

You must pick up after your dog.

Excessive barking complaints will result in your dog not being allowed on the campground.

Dog fees are \$2 night or \$10 week per dog for short term campers and \$50 per dog for seasonal campers.

ENTIRE CAMPGROUND IS A POOPER SCOOPER ZONE!

Do Not:

Wash cars, boats or camper using campground water.

Cut trees whether dead or alive. Firewood is available in the canteen.

No guns allowed on the campground.

No fireworks allowed on the campsite.

No drinking which results in objectionable and belligerent behavior.

No loitering.

Use a motor generator at any time.

Do not feed the ducks.
